COUNCIL CORNER...

- † **ELDER REPORT.** Based on positive responses to the April 30th Praise Service, there will be Praise Services on July 30th and October 29th. The Trinity Men's Ministry will focus on issues to include social ministry, Bible study, service projects, and outreach to youth in the community.
- † **ENDOWMENT COMMITTEE.** The completed Endowment Fund By-Laws were presented to the congregation on June 4th and approved. The next step is the formation of an implementation committee consisting of three congregation members at large, two Council members (the Vice President and Treasurer) and the Pastor.
- † **FINANCIAL REPORT.** Our April 2023 receipts were \$7,905 more than Budget. Our April 2023 expenses were \$3,019 more than budget. We have an April surplus of \$4,886 and a year-to-date budget surplus of \$41,946.
- † **LAND COMMITTEE.** There was another public hearing concerning the proposed multifamily buildings that would occupy the land adjacent to the church. The Town Council voted down the rezoning the parcel of land to multifamily.
- † **MINISTRY REPORT.** Currently La Mesa needs backpacks, deodorant, women's clothing, and food. The Ministry Team authorized a donation of \$500 to Lutheran Social Services to support their efforts in resettlement of 121 Ukrainian refugees in the Phoenix and Tucson areas.
- † **TRUSTEES.** All roof repairs have been completed. The church has received a \$16,000 bid to purchase an electronic, secure front door system; other alternatives and bids are being investigated. A private building contractor with audio-visual expertise has offered to review our sanctuary upgrade bids and thinks the costs can be significantly reduced.
- † **CHURCH WEBSITE:** The website is being updated by Jason and Dana. Please be patient with this process.

PRAYER WARRIORS AND PRAYER TIME...



Prayer Warriors meets the second and fourth Mondays every month at 9:30 a.m. in the Prayer Room. In June, they will meet on the 12th and the 26th. In July, they will meet on the 10th and the 24th.

Prayer Time on Sunday mornings begins at 9:10 a.m., before the 9:30 a.m. worship service. Each Prayer Time session should last

Old Business:

Grace Respite - The LWML will again prepare meals for Grace Respite which will take place on Thursday, July 20th. They are putting the finishing touches on the actual menu, but will pack lunch bags of cookies, fruit, etc. at 9:30 A.M. on the 20th at the church and depart for Grace Respite at 10:30 A.M. There is a sign-up sheet on the bulletin board in the hallway for anyone that would like to help in meal preparation, packing up and serving for the respite.

Extended Hands Food Bank - The LWML has had labels printed up to put on the food packaging that is taken to the food bank. They will say "Jesus Loves you and does so does Trinity Lutheran Church". The food was delivered to the food bank on Tuesday, June 6th along with \$140.00 in donations.

Ministry Student - John B. has graduated and it was voted to send \$200 for a graduation gift from LWML. They also discussed if they want to support another student next year. A motion was made to fund a student \$500 per year for 4 years. It was decided to have a later discussion regarding this.

Backpacks - Back to School Backpacks will again be offered for students in need and distributed on July 8th. Church volunteers will fill the backpacks with school supplies and hand them to the students. Our local model and junior movie star, Mirabel S., who is the granddaughter of our members Terry and Debbie O. will be on hand to pass out Ice Cream cones!

Christmas Tree at Community Center - The set up of the Trinity LWML Christmas tree is November 18th. A new leader to take over the set up as Debbie O. would like to step down.
